Parent Guidelines

As a Parent I will:

I will exemplify good sportsmanship.

I will act as a representative of PSA and the Force program at all times.

I will remember that the game is for the players, not for the adults.

I will show respect at all times for coaches, referees, players, spectators, and club officials.

I will refrain from yelling or loudly questioning the referees' judgment and let the coaches handle interactions with the referees during games.

I will never harass an opposing player, a player on my child's team, or any team personnel.

I will cheer good plays and encourage players from the sidelines, applauding performance and remind players to keep their spirit and energy in the game.

I will ensure my child arrives at all events dressed, equipped and ready to play.

I will support the player code of conduct and help my player follow it.

With respect to my players' development:

I will let the coaches provide the only coaching to the players. By doing this I know that I am supporting the players' development.

I will encourage my child to speak with the coach on a regular basis on what they need to do to improve.

I will support my players to take ownership for their development.

I will encourage them to spend additional time on their own with the ball.

I recognize that development of the team depends on the contribution of all the players and their relationships with each other.

I will help my child arrive on time to any scheduled event, remembering early is on time, on time is late. In the event we need to miss or be late for training, I will inform the coach as early as possible.

** I will pay my players soccer fees in full, or in monthly payments of \$155.00 a month, due the 1st of each month until all fees are paid in full.

I understand that if payments are late or become delinquent, player may be suspended from playing games/practices until fees are caught up or arrangements are made.
